
- ◎ Make sure that developing countries have voting rights, so that they can become more legitimate institutions

 - ◎ Apply differential treatment for developing countries
 - ◎ Reduce transaction cost for migrant remittances



For 70 years UNHCR (the UN refugee agency) has had support from the US government and people





Where America's Refugees Come From


Top 10 origin countries for refugees admitted to the U.S. in FY 2018

Top 10 U.S. states resettling refugees in FY2018





- ◎ Severely reduced the number of refugees admitted through the resettlement programme
- ◎ Ban a citizens travelling from a group of mainly Muslim Majority countries
- ◎ Wants to restore the US refugee resettlement programme with more numbers admitted
- ◎ Going to help with forced displacement around the world

Africa



- ◎ Only 15% of Sub-Saharan Africa had electricity access
- ◎ Continent lacks important infrastructure investments
- ◎ Most of its population live in poverty

To combat this...

- ◎ New Partnership for Africa's Development, launched by African heads of state in 2001
 - aims at providing framework for sustainable development to be shared by all Africa's people
 - plan to eradicate poverty through sustained economic growth and sustainable development

The UN has also helped...

- ◎ Established Office of Special Adviser on Africa
- ◎ Consider Africa a cross cutting issue in the Johannesburg Plan of Implementation (see chapter VIII)
- ◎ Heavily Indebted and Poor countries program
 - Made in 1966 by the International monetary fund and the World Bank



The health and well being of millions of Venezuelan refugees and migrants is being threatened by COVID-19

Income for migrants

- ◎ Undermined the livelihoods of millions of migrants and their families
 - Money migrants send home to their countries has gone down (for remittances)
- ◎ Income for migrants in countries with diaspora will be negatively affected
 - 18 million born in India live outside the country
 - Mexico, the Russian Federation (11 million each), China (10 million) and Syria (eight million)

The number of refugees is rising

- ◎ Why is it rising
 - Conflicts, crises
 - Persecution
 - Violence
 - Human rights violation
- ◎ Refugees have doubled from 17 to 34 million since the beginning of the 21st century

- ◎ Volunteer in a local refugee camp
 - Or start a donation drive
- ◎ Organize a conversation space at a local shelter, orphanages or minority community centers to discuss the importance of this goal.
